WHAT TYPE OF DATA IS BEING REQUESTED AND WHERE IS IT HELD?

UK Brain Bank Network (UKBBN)

- neuropathology data
- “some” genetic data (EGA data)
- assessment summary data on deceased donors

Brain Banks (BB)

Data relating to specific tissue requests.

Dementia Platform UK (DPUK)



- “some” genetic data (exome sequencing and neuroX data).
- Data uploaded by DPUK users
- assessment data

WHAT APPROVALS ARE REQUIRED?



Your request will be reviewed by the Data Access Committee in Newcastle

For small/simple requests, data may be released without additional approval.
If approval is required, application will be reviewed by local BB committees



Request will be reviewed by BDR Unified Access Committee (UAC)
